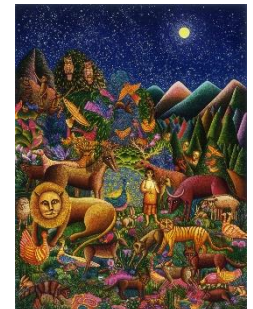


I was glad when they said to me,

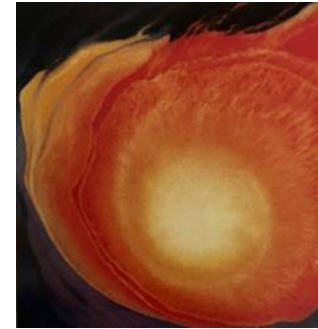
