<p>Thursday September 15, 2022 Centering Prayer</p>	<p>Psalm 113:3, 7 NRSV From the rising of the sun to its setting the name of the LORD is to be praised. Praise the Lord... who raises the poor from the dust, and lifts the needy from the ash heap. Or Psalm 79:8-9 NRSV Let your compassion come speedily to meet us, for we are brought very low. Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of your name, deliver us, and forgive our sins, for your name's sake.</p>
<p>Wednesday September 21, 2022 Lectio</p>	<p>Psalm 91:1-6, 14-16 ELW You who live in the shelter of the Most High, who abide in the shadow of the Almighty, will say to the LORD, "My refuge and my stronghold; my God, in whom I put my trust." For God will rescue you from the snare of the hunter and from the deadly plague. God's wings will cover you and you will find refuge beneath them; God's faithfulness will be your shield and defense. You shall not fear any terror of the night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the plague that stalks in the darkness, nor the sickness that lays in waste at noon. I will deliver those who cling to me; I will uphold them, because they know my name. They will call me, and I will answer them; I will be with them in trouble, I will rescue them and honor them. With long life I will satisfy them, and show them my salvation.</p>
